Principal Rating Scale

Work based on the MDE model...

- Unsatisfactory:** This means the principal does not perform in an acceptable way most of the time in the area under examination.
- Satisfactory:** This means the principal performs in an acceptable way at least some of the time in the area under examination.
- Accomplished:** This means the principal consistently performs in an acceptable way in the area under examination.
- Distinguished:** This means the principal goes above and beyond what might be expected in the area under examination.
- Developing:** This means the principal is still learning and growing in the area under examination; it might be too early to assign a rating...
